The Social Skills Program

-  The Social Skills program runs once a week for 8 weeks giving your child the opportunity to develop and practice their social skills
-  Focused on fun play-based activities and semi-structured social situations which include fun materials, role-play, videos and social games
-  Run in 2 hour sessions with a small group of up to 8 children
-  The program is implemented by a multi-disciplinary team consisting of a Senior Behavioural therapist/Provisional Psychologist and a Speech therapist assisted by Junior therapists
-  Progress is measured and you will receive a final report

This is a great opportunity for children with ASD to practise their social skills within a safe group setting

Participants are engaged and encouraged to participate in:

-  Social interaction and conversational skills
-  Play initiation – partaking, developing and maintaining friendships
-  Emotional regulation and expression
-  Identifying needs and communicating them
